Cracking the Safety Code workshop

What safety management approach would work best for your company

Most safety practitioners rely primarily on one or two approaches to manage safety in their organisation. This workshop explains how there are four mainstream approaches for managing safety which can be used to improve safety performance in companies.

The workshop maps the four mainstream approaches for managing safety along the journey to Zero Harm and assesses the effectiveness of each in helping your company achieve a resilient safety culture.

It also outlines the future direction for safety and reveals the new mindset that has helped organisations reduce their incident rates significantly (irrespective of where they are at culturally).

Intended audience:

- Safety Managers, Safety Advisers and Safety Co-ordinators
- Plant Managers and Site Managers
- Anyone involved or interested in improving safety performance

Content and format:

The workshop begins with a brief history of safety to understand the current mindset ("hazards cause injuries, not people") and why we manage safety the way we do today.

The workshop deals with:

- Safety Management Systems (SMS)

An information flowchart is built for a typical SMS to allow participants to understand how an SMS comes together.

It also takes a critical look at some aspects of the risk management process, eliminates those that add little value and proposes a simplification of the process to achieve a more consistent result.

- Safety Leadership

The workshop outlines what is meant by safety leadership and the mantras of good safety leadership, and details the safety leadership behaviours that are critical.

- Behaviour Based Safety (BBS)

The workshop explores the theory of BBS and the requirements to make such an undertaking work.

- Human Error

Everyone knows that people make mistakes - this workshop explores how people make mistakes and what can be done personally to minimise Human Error for you and your company.

- What approach to use in your company - based on where your company is at in their safety journey
- The potential impact each of these approaches can have on safety performance
