

E-Learning via Intranet

What is e-learning?

The term e-learning (also described as electronic learning) encompasses most forms of technology-based learning, and covers a wide set of applications including:

computer-based learning

- Web-based training
- digital collaboration

It is crucial to remember that e-learning is not expected to replace classroom training but instead enhance it, offering greater choice and the chance for an organisation to provide a complete learning solution for their staff.

What are the benefits of e-Learning?

- Provides a quick and easy way to make video content available for training use.
- Enables training sessions to become more flexible allowing employees to access the materials anytime.
- Content may be paused or replayed according to individual needs in order to extract maximum benefits from the training program.
- Saves additional time and money involved in setting up group training sessions for large numbers of people – you can train employees at minimal cost per person.
- Removes the need for multiple copies of DVDs for multiple sites.
- Easy to use.
- Also works well with facilitator-led training - staff can access a video before a workshop.
- Employees can download associated guides and handouts themselves thus saving additional costs of print and paper.
- Helps employees develop computer skills vital in all professions.

What is Intranet-based e-Learning?

With Intranet-based e-learning, we can licence your organisation to put our training content on your company's intranet from where you and your employees can access it from multiple locations (sites), anytime, anywhere!

What are the benefits of Intranet-based e-learning?

- The content is personalised with your company's logo.
- Confidential reports about completed training and test scores are maintained on the company's in-house server.
- Potential to upload customised tests on your intranet for employees to complete after viewing the individual program online.
- Potential to integrate with custom applications developed by in-house IT managers.
- Convert the video into any format and set it up to play with the player application of your choice.

- Viewing and replaying the video content multiple times does not affect Internet bandwidth, since the material is stored on the organisation's in-house server.
- Training is not affected by potential Internet connectivity and security problems.
- Control who can view the videos.

How much does it cost?

We offer a licencing agreement authorising the use of the program on your company's intranet. The licence fee is based on the number of employees who can access the content. The cost will also be determined by the terms of the licence period eg. one, two or three years. This way you can train your employees at minimal cost per person.

How does it work?

You can setup e-Learning via intranet for your organisation in 3 easy steps:

- You complete a licence agreement and provide us your corporate logo which will be used to customise the program. Adding your logo to the program personalises it for your employees- and also deters any use by other companies not licenced to use the program. We will then supply CDs (containing enriched files) of the program.
- Your IT department loads the files onto your intranet server.
- You and your employees can log in and view the video content simply by connecting to the company's intranet!
