

Offline Video Licence

Training video content supplied as a digital video file (eg.mp4) by the copyright proprietor (producer) with an Offline Licence, will provide the licensee the option of viewing, accessing and storing the video content from/on multiple devices in an offline environment.

Acceptable devices include: laptop computer, desktop computer, USB thumb drive or portable hard drive.

The video content has been licenced for its intended use only and strictly prohibits any other use.

Conditions of use for the video content with an Offline Licence include:

1. The video file must not be uploaded to any online platform such as company intranet, Internet, or Learning Management System, where it can be accessed and viewed via an online connection.
2. The video file is for training purposes and internal use only.
3. The video file can be accessed and delivered through multiple devices providing they are all in an offline environment.
4. The Offline Licence does not allow for any editing or modification of the video content. Permission must be granted from the producer for this to occur.
